Formal Approaches:

- Maths Drop In Meetings – November and March
- Annual Report – July
- Additional Parents' Evening for any parents whose children we are concerned about – January and April
- Termly One Plan Meetings for children on the Inclusion Register

Informal Approaches:

- Communication Strategy (accessed via the front page of our website)
- Weekly newsletter
- Phone calls home/to school
- Reading diary notes
- Emails to/from Year Group email account
- Interim meetings with class teacher, Year Group Leader, Inclusion Manager or Headteacher
- Daily communication dairies for children with particular needs
